

Case Study: Navigating MSHDA MI Neighborhood Program



Client's Initial Challenges

A client needed expert guidance to align their project with Mi Neighborhood program goals.

The project fit the scope and design of the MI Neighborhood program; specifically, requesting funding for rehabilitating the exteriors and some interior work on two rental duplexes.


GLHS Strategic Approach

GLHS assisted with the development of a rental proforma and provided suitable specs and pictures.

Outcome and Impact

As a result, the client successfully secured \$160,000 in funding. The project improved local infrastructure and fostered community cohesion, benefiting residents significantly.

Case Study: Technical Assistance in Genesee County



Understanding the Issue

The United Way of Genesee County received a budget appropriation from the State of Michigan to provide a wide variety housing solutions to Genesee County's housing ecosystem.

This includes expanding the capacity of the County's homeless continuum of care, assisting in the development and funding of affordable housing projects, and creating new attainable home ownership opportunities for residents.


Collaborative Solutions

GLHS has been retained to provide guidance and technical expertise to assist the United Way of Genesee County and its local government and nonprofit partners in the creation and implementation of unique and impactful programs that will provide various types of needed housing to communities in Genesee County.

Ongoing Support

GLHS will be engaging with stakeholders, local governments, developers, and residents, as well as assisting the United Way of Genesee County in the development of strategy, program parameters, RFPs, and, ultimately, the execution of these programs during this multi-year engagement.

Case Study: Third-Party CDBG and Downpayment Assistance Support



Context

Many communities struggle to effectively deploy CDBG funds and manage downpayment assistance (DPA) programs due to complex regulations, administrative burden, and lack of capacity.

Without proper guidance, funds may go unused or programs may fail to reach the intended beneficiaries.

Opportunity

GLHS can partner with local governments and their partners to simplify compliance, improve program execution, and maximize community impact.

Leveraging GLHS' expertise, we can help unlock funding that might otherwise go underutilized.

Solution

GLHS recently partnered with a city government on CDBG administration for single family home rehabilitation program.

GLHS is well equipped to step in to fill the gap by offering structured, hands-on support.



Services Available for Tribes

- The Tribal Nations Housing Development Assistance Program (TNHDAP) offers pre-development grants to support tribes in early-stage planning and assessment.
- These grants can fund feasibility studies, environmental assessments, and architectural design plans, ensuring tribes are well-prepared for construction phases.
- Support includes access to a network of expert consultants in housing development and finance, providing tribes with tailored advice and strategies.
- The program encourages sustainable and culturally relevant housing solutions, aligning development projects with the unique needs of each tribal community.
- Tribes receive ongoing technical assistance and workshops to enhance their capacity in project management and grant application processes.
