

2025 MDOT Advance Training Wheels Series Virtual On-Road Bicycle Facility Design Training

This virtual online course on the newest planning and designs for on-road bicycle facilities will be split into two days (participants must register each class individually). It consists of state and national guidance, showcases Michigan communities, and analyzes various types of bicycle accommodations, including separated and buffered bike lanes

Target Audience: This course is for city, county and Michigan Department of Transportation

(MDOT) managers, engineers, planners, elected officials, downtown development authority (DDA) staff, economic development staff, township officials, chambers of commerce, and other partners who can help educate

people about on-road bicycle facilities.

self-report for Certification Maintenance hours.

provided in advance. It is not necessary to ride the route, the route map is made available if you choose to see the infrastructure firsthand. Virtual bike routes are provided in coordination with cities, local agencies, advocacy

groups, and Toole Design.
